



Reserve Law

- In order to open up land for European immigrants the Canadian government moved Aboriginal communities onto reserves
- Reserve law made it illegal to leave the reserve without written permission from the Indian Agent

Leading up to Residential School

- Indian Day Schools were started on your reserves
 - Intent of the school was to "Civilize and Christianize" the students
 - Students attended school during the day and went home to their families after school



Day schools not affective

 Why weren't Indian Day Schools affective in "Civilizing" Aboriginal students?





The problem with Indian Day Schools

 "When a white child goes to his home, the father and mother talk to him in the language that he will use through his life. His surroundings are the best. Everything tends to advance the white boy. Not so the Indian. Four hours at school – 20 hours with his parents talking the Haida language and continuing the ways of the Indian...learning nothing that is useful, and seeing a great deal that the young should avoid." Thomas Deasey, Indian Agent



Residential schools are established

- In partnership with Canadian churches
- Residential schools were built throughout Canada to "Civilize and Christianize" Aboriginal children
- Attendance at residential school was mandatory for children age 5 to 15




The Residential School


